## **Performance Notes:**

For a solo/chamber music setting:

The stage should be set up as appropriate for the predetermined instrumentation. All performers enter the stage with instruments, then graciously bow in reception of the applause. All performers then exit the stage. Any traditional formalities which normally accompany a performance should be followed.

**Note:** If the audience does not applaud at first, it may be advisable for the performers to look into the audience as if expecting applause, or just bow anyway.

## For a large ensemble setting:

Ensemble is on stage awaiting its conductor. The conductor enters the stage, then graciously bows in reception of the applause. The conductor then exits the stage. If desired, a soloist, group of soloists, or accompanist may also be employed. Any traditional formalities which normally accompany a performance should be followed.
