




Performance Notes

Required Instrumentation

5/16" x 3" fully-threaded, zinc-plated screws, pan heads, 4 pair

2 branches, with leaves (time should be allowed for the leaves to die after tearing the branches off the tree, for a crispier sound)

microphone (with stand) and speaker

stereo/boom box (running on batteries) and accompanying performance CD

train whistle

bicycle

box fan

stool

Pop Rocks™ candy

Rice Krispies™ cereal

carafe of milk

bowl and spoon


2 umbrellas

bottled soda

hat

Proprietary Symbols

Throughout the score, a diagram of the stage is used. This is what it looks like and how it should be interpreted:



For example, a direction such as this:

should be read as: "Within the timeframce of about 4 seconds, walk from up center stage and exit stage right, while carrying the stereo."


Other actions in a box, like this:

should be performed quickly in one action, because they are too brief to be timed.

Some actions are sustained by a thick, black line, and may use a dynamic countour: screws (cricket sounds, ad libitum):

blow into microphone: (wind sounds) OR

Arrows pointing to events show either sequence or simultaneity of actions:



Performance Preparation

2 stands can be set up off either side of the stage to hold music and a stopwatch.

Before a performance, the props should be set up as follows:

Offstage left

Offstage right 2 pairs of screws 2 pairs of screws

2 branches stool

stereo (containing CD) hat

> train whistle bicvcle


box fan (may be propped up on a chair)

Pop Rocks™ candy

box of Rice Krispies™ cereal

carafe of milk bowl and spoon 2 umbrellas bottled soda

The microphone should be set up on a stand at right center stage, and the speaker should be off the right side of the stage, as illustrated:



During rehearsal, it may be helpful to mark the floor with tape, so important spots can be easily found.

Things in the score that aren't specifically written out may be interpreted by the performer (for example, the prop "hat" may be a baseball cap, or it could be a sombrero, or something else.)

The screws should be played to imitate crickets, by holding each toward the head with two fingers, and quickly scraping them together lengthwise.

Performer Roles

There are no specific "characters" in this piece, but each performer does have a vague sort of role:

Performers 1 and 2 are two friends out barhopping. They do most of their actions together.

Performer 3 keeps thinking (s)he recognizes someone else as a philosophy major.

Performer 4 is a male role, and he plays the role of a waiter in the piece. He should be wearing something of a waiter, whether it's an apron, or a fancy tuxedo, et cetera.


Performer 5 shakes branches for most of the piece.

Performer 6 is a female role, and she is in search of food. She has a starring role with performer 4 in a "dining scene". She should be wearing a nice dress.

Performer 7 is another male role, and he rides a bicycle, which is later stolen. He also becomes an angel.

Performer 8 walks with a stereo most of the time.

Each performer (except 4 and 6) should wear their interpretation of "street clothes".
